RUGBY'S HOUSING PLANS

Dunchurch Parish Council wants to know your views on the Borough Council's proposals for substantial housing development in the borough - particularly in South West Rugby.

The Facts

The Borough Council propose that **12,400 homes should be built in Rugby between 2011 and 2031**. 2,800 of these would be to meet needs arising in Coventry. It would mean increasing recent rates of house building in Rugby by about 55%. **Up to 5,000 new homes would be built in South West Rugby** on open land between Dunchurch, Cawston and Rugby Town, although probably only about 2,800 of them by 2031. New roads would link the A4071 near Potsford Dam with the A426 near Sainsburys, through the development. In addition a new village of about 1,500 homes would be built at **Lodge Farm near Willoughby** on the A45 between Dunchurch and Braunston.
